

## **ASCLS-HI Membership Committee Report**

1. As of November 8, 2020, we have a total of 92 members in ASCLS-HI (with no out-of-state students, except one from CA who will be returning to HI). This is a net gain of five members from a year ago (11-5-19) due to new members minus lapsed members.
2. We had 19 lapsed members at the start of the lapsed member campaign at the beginning of October this year. Last year we also had 19 lapsed members. Of the 19 lapsed members this year, three have renewed as of this date (11-8-20). Two lapsed members have retired (one is not eligible for Emeritus status and the other one does not want it). The campaign is officially completed.
